### Important Things to Consider when Selecting a Confirmation Sponsor and Name

#### **CONFIRMATION SPONSOR:**

Consider your choice of a Confirmation sponsor thoughtfully. This person should be someone who is willing and able to offer support in your journey of faith, both by example and guidance. Your sponsor should be a witness of Christ in your life. The choice of a Confirmation sponsor is different than the selection of a favorite family member or friend because the role of sponsor is not just an honor, it is also a responsibility. Someone who is causal or indifferent about their practice of their faith may not be the best choice.

- Catholic sponsors have specific roles they play in the lives of their candidates. They:
  - Pray regularly for them
  - Give an example of Catholic living
  - Encourage their religious education
- Catholic sponsor should be active members of the Church community
- Sponsors cannot be a parent of the candidate
- Catholic sponsors should:
  - o Be mature enough to assume the responsibility of this role and be 16 years or older
  - o Have received the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist
  - o Be a practicing member of the Catholic Church
  - o If married, his/her marriage was performed by a Catholic priest or deacon

The ancient tradition in the Catholic Church of sponsor is a beautiful one and provides us with a person in our lives who models their faith, lives their faith, and is joyful and enthusiastic about sharing their faith!

Please remember that a sponsor needs to obtain a sponsor form from their current parish!

#### **CONFIRMATION NAME:**

Likewise, choose your Confirmation name thoughtfully. Your choice should be made based on the life lived by the saint you choose. Rather than choosing a name you happen to like, you should focus on the example set by the saint's life and reflect on the following questions:

- How did this saint model Gospel values?
- How was this saint a witness to the life of Jesus?
- How did this saint live a life of service to others?
- How did this saint actually live his/her faith?
- Why do I connect with this saint?
- What message does this saint's life have for me to apply to my life today?

#### IMPORTANT INFORMATION TO NOTE

- We should receive our date for the Sacrament of Confirmation from the Diocese in Spring 2024. Our hope is to have a Sunday date in early November.
- Students should be enrolled in either St. Joseph Parish Day School or St. Joseph Parish School of Religion. As in the past, a candidate for Confirmation has received both Baptism and Eucharist and has participated in previous religious education day school or PSR programs. If you have not met the above qualifications, you are invited to enroll in the Confirmation process. However, in order to do so, please call our Parish DRE, Rozann Swanson, or Youth Minister, Michael Grecol.
- Students will attend a total of 10 Confirmation sessions throughout the course of the school year,
  outside of either Day School or PSR classes. In addition to these sessions, students will participate in a
  Confirmation Retreat and service activities totaling no less than 30 hours. The purpose of these
  sessions is to build community and to provide opportunities for students to grow together in their faith
  journey as one Confirmation class.
- Students are responsible to return completed packets no later than the listed due dates. Packets can be turned in as soon as they are complete.
- Dress code for Confirmation:
  - o Girls:
    - White blouse (not a tee) and a plain black, navy, grey, or khaki skirt of appropriate length (not a mini...think at least fingertip length). Black, navy, grey, or khaki dress pants are also an acceptable option instead of a skirt
    - OR a plain white, black, navy, grey or khaki dress
  - o Boys:
    - White dress shirt and dark, conservative tie with black, navy, grey or khaki dress pants
    - A black/navy/grey suit with a white dress shirt and dark, conservative tie
  - The basic thing to remember for all students: dress nice, dress modest, try to keep within the color guideline if possible.
  - I am not one to try and split hairs over outfits and I trust the parents to have the final say over how their child dresses. If the parents feel that the outfit is appropriate and modest, the outfit should be fine.
